## BILLING INFORMATION

All water bill payments are due by the tenth (10th) day of the month. A late charge of **\$20.00** will be added to the account if payment is not received by the Corporation on or before the tenth (10th) day of the month.

If the account is not settled in full by the end of the business day on the twenty sixth (26th), the meter will be locked for non-payment on or as soon as reasonable after the twenty sixth (26th) day of the month. A reconnect fee of **\$70.00** plus the account balance will be required to reconnect / unlock any service that has been disconnected / locked due to delinquency.

Accounts turned off due to delinquent status will be turned back on after payment of delinquent bill, during normal work hours of: **7:30 AM to 4:30 PM**.

If the water is required to be turned on after working hours there will be an additional **\$100.00** due for the trip charge. **OPERATOR CAN NOT ACCEPT PAYMENT IN FIELD, PAYMENT MUST BE MADE AT THE OFFICE**

Payment of bill by check returned for insufficient funds or Automatic Draft not covered will cost **\$35.00**, plus you will lose the privilege of payment by check or Automatic Draft for six (6) months minimum.

## LAVON WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION DROUGHT STAGE 3 (SEVERE) EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 01, 2011

The lack of rainfall has brought all the supply lakes for N.T.M.W.D. to a seriously low level, prompting North Texas Municipal Water District to implement **Stage 3 Restrictions** of the **Drought Contingency Plan**.

Lavon Water Supply Corporation's Stage 3 of the Drought Contingency Plan, limits ALL outside watering to ONE time every two weeks and NO watering between 10:00 AM and 6:00 PM, with an overall 10% reduction in usage.

Beginning, **November 01, 2011** this plan will be in effect and will require all members to follow these **MANDATORY RULES**. **Failure to follow the rules could result in fines.**

**Addresses ending in even numbers water on Saturdays of the First and Third weekends of the month, anytime after 6:00 pm and before 10:00 am.**

**Addresses ending in odd numbers water on Sundays of the First and Third weekends of the month, anytime after 6:00 pm and before 10:00 am.**

1. When using a water hose always use an automatic shut off on the hose nozzle.
2. Don't water between 10:00 AM and 06:00 PM.; it results in evaporation and waste.
3. Prevent excess watering that causes runoff.
4. Repair broken or misaligned sprinkler heads to avoid waste.
5. Refrain from hosing non-pervious surfaces like driveways and sidewalks.
6. Don't water when it's raining or about to.
7. No ornamental water fountain use allowed during drought.
8. Do not drain and refill swimming pools except to replace normal water loss.
9. Foundations, new landscaping, new plantings (first year) of shrubs, and trees may be watered for up to two hours on any day by a hand-held hose or a soaker hose.

Wait until the current drought has passed before establishing new landscaping and no hydroseeding, hydromulching, or sprigging allowed.

The 2012 Texas State Water Plan is available at [www.twdb.state.tx.us](http://www.twdb.state.tx.us). The State Water Plan is updated every 5 years to ensure that Texas will have enough water to meet it's needs during a drought of record.
